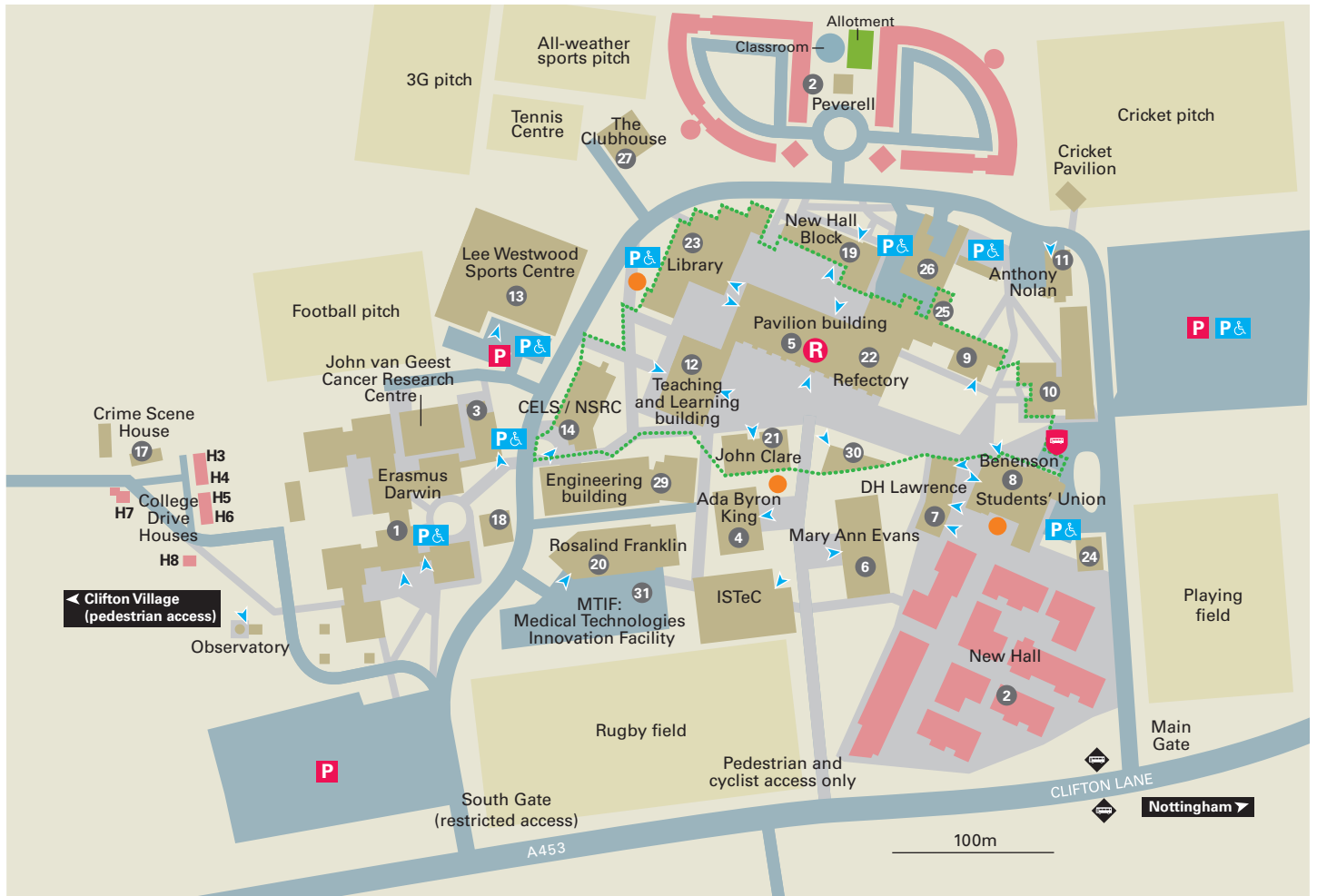

How to get here

By car

Nottingham is at the heart of the country and is well served by the motorway network. The M1 passes close to the west of the city, the A42 / M42 link to the south-west of the city, and the A1(M) to the east of the city.

Our Clifton Campus is located on the A453 Clifton Lane. When using the M1 to reach our Clifton Campus, exit at Junction 24 and follow the A453 for approximately five miles. From the city centre, follow signs out to the A453 (signposted to Birmingham).

Car parking

Limited on-site parking is available at our Clifton Campus. Enter the campus through the Main Gate. Contact security at the car park barrier using the intercom, and you'll be directed to the student car park.

By bus

During term time, the Uni 4 bus runs between our City and Clifton campuses. The service leaves Burton Street (adjacent to The Cornerhouse) up to every seven minutes for the Clifton Campus, via the city centre and the railway station.

Out of term time, use the Nottingham City Transport (NCT) service number 1, which picks up at Beastmarket Hill, Collin Street and the railway station, and drops off at the gates of our Clifton Campus.

By coach

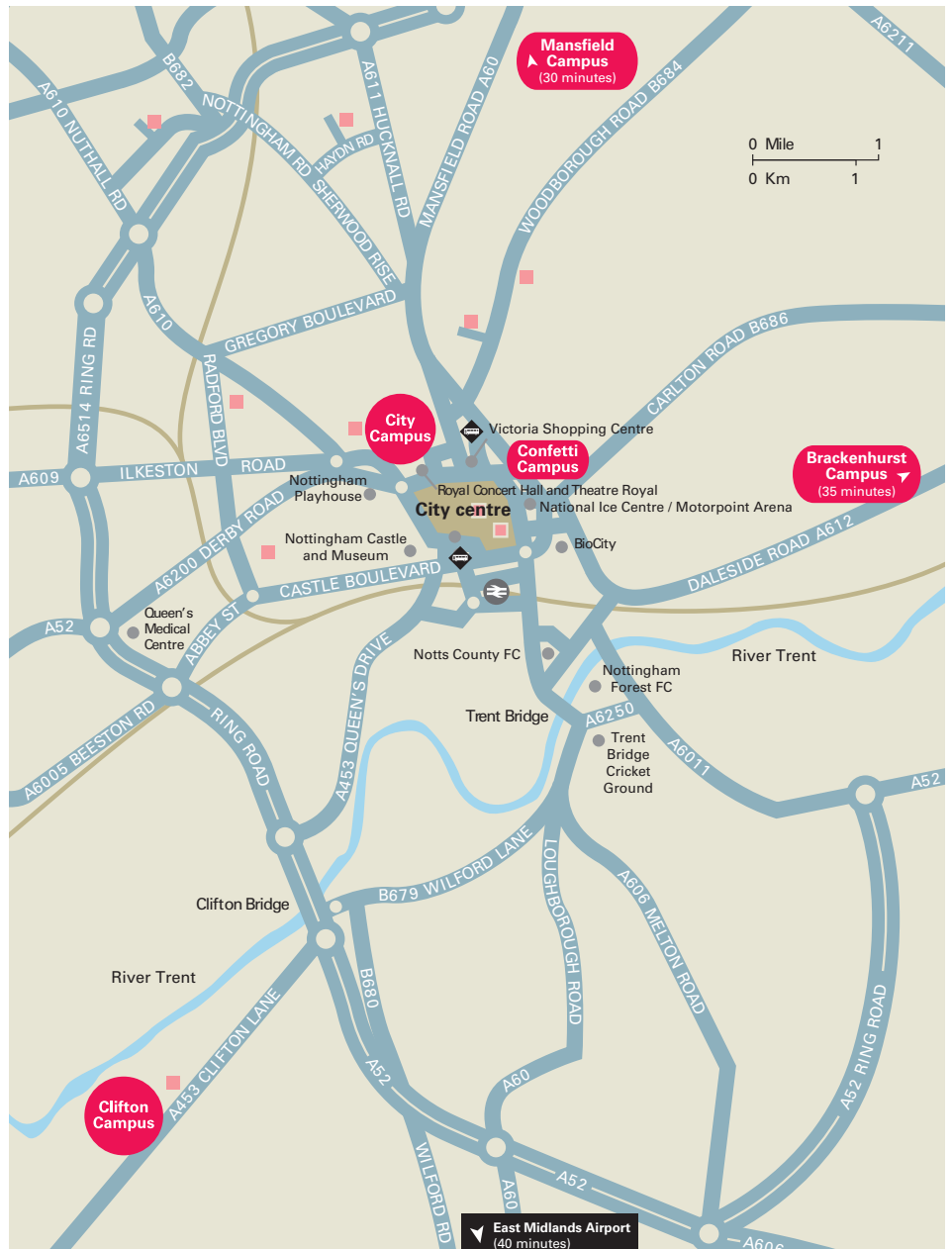
National Express coach services operate from Station Street, beside the railway station. The buses referred to above can then be used to reach our Clifton Campus.
